

COLORADO STATESMAN

OVERVIEW

The Colorado Statesman pin recognizes Colorado TSA members who excel in knowledge of the organization, its foundation, and its history. The Colorado Statesman exam is given at the annual State Conference.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to middle school and high school chapters. One (1) entry per member is allowed. There is no limit for the number of members per chapter.

PREPARATION

- A. Test questions will be pulled from the National TSA and Colorado TSA websites, the Colorado TSA Call to Conference, and from Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised (12th Edition).
- B. Test questions may include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Information and history
 - b. Membership information
 - c. News and media
 - d. Awards
 - e. Basic parliamentary procedure

REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- A. The Exam
 - a. The use of reference materials or external assistance is not permitted during the exam..
 - b. Participants will only be allowed one (1) opportunity to take the exam.
- B. Submission
 - a. Testing information will be provided in the Colorado TSA State Competitive Events Guide.
- C. Participants who receive a score above 75% will be announced and receive a Colorado Statesman lapel pin.

EVALUATION

Pins will be earned based on the following criteria:

- A score of 75-83% will be recognized with a Red Colorado Statesman lapel pin
- A score of 84-92% will be recognized with a White Colorado Statesman lapel pin
- A score of 93-99% will be recognized with a Blue Colorado Statesman lapel pin
- A score of 100% will be recognized with a Gold Colorado Statesman lapel pin
